ADVERTISEMENT

1. **Bids** - The Ocean County Utilities Authority, Bayville, New Jersey, will receive sealed Bids delivered to 501 Hickory Lane, Bayville, New Jersey 08721, for **Contract No. AW1133 – CWPCF/SWPCF Boiler Flue Improvements** until 2 p.m., local time on **Wednesday, February 15, 2012**, when all Bids duly received will be opened publicly and read aloud.

2. **Project Description** - Contract No. AW1133 – CWPCF/SWPCF Boiler Flue Improvements, the Work, includes, but is not necessarily limited to: Demolition and replacement at the CWPCF of the exhaust stack (flue) for a 300 Hp Burnham Boiler. The intent of the new flue is to allow condensate to be collected and treated prior to the condensate entering the boiler.

Demolition and replacement at the SWPCF of the exhaust flues for two 200 Hp Superior Boilers. The intent of the new flues is to allow condensate to be collected and treated prior to the condensate entering the boiler.

The work includes installing new roof openings for the flues, closing of existing roof openings, roofing system restoration, and preservation roofing system warranties.

The sites are located at CWPCF, 501 Hickory Lane, Bayville, NJ 08721 and SWPCF, 150 Cedar Run Dock Road, Cedar Run, NJ 08092, as shown on the Drawings.

3. **Bidding Documents** - Full sets of Bidding Documents may be picked up from **The Ocean County Utilities Authority**, 501 Hickory Lane, Bayville, New Jersey 08721, on or after **Wednesday, January 25, 2012**, on Business Days between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. A non-refundable check in the amount of **\$75** made payable to the Ocean County Utilities Authority, will be required for each set of complete Bidding Documents requested by a prospective Bidder or any other party.

Bidding Documents will be shipped **only** if the requesting party includes their overnight shipping service number.

4. **Bid Security** - In accordance with N.J.S.A. 40A:11-21, each Bid shall enclose Bid Security, as specified in the Instructions to Bidders, in the amount of ten percent (10%) of the Bidder's Base Bid plus all alternates, but not in excess of \$20,000.

5. **Site Visit/Pre-Bid Conference** - A site visit/pre-bid conference will be held on **Wednesday, February 1, 2012, at 9 a.m.** at the Central Water Pollution Control Facility (CWPCF). The site visit/pre-bid conference will take approximately four hours. All Bidders (or their authorized representatives) are strongly encouraged to attend the site visit/pre-bid conference. Other parties interested in the Work are encouraged to attend the tour and pre-bid conference.

6. **Addenda** - Notice of revisions or addenda to advertisement or bid documents shall be in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40A:11-23(a) and N.J.S.A. 40A:11-23(c).
7. **Bidders** are required to comply with the requirements of P.L. 1975, c. 127 (N.J.S.A. 10:5-31 et seq. and N.J.A.C. 17:27), equal employment opportunities P.L. 1977, c.33, corporate and/or partnership ownership and P.L. 2004, c. 57, business registration of public contracts and the "Public Works Contractor Registration Act" (N.J.S.A. 34:11).
8. **Local Public Contract Requirements** - The New Jersey Department of Labor and Industry's Prevailing Wage Determination for the Work, Confirmation No. 032147 is attached.
9. **New Jersey Election Law Enforcement Commission** - Bidders will be required to comply with the requirements of the New Jersey Election Law Enforcement Commission pursuant to N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.4 and N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.13 (P.L. 2005, c271, s.3).
10. **Surety Bonding** - In accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:22-3.17(g) and N.J.A.C. 7:22-4.17(g), all applicable surety bonds required in connection with the advertisement and award of building contracts or subagreements must be written by a surety company listed on the Federal Treasury List (Department Circular 570-Surety Companies Acceptable on Federal Bonds), incorporated herein by reference. Copies of this document may be obtained from the United States Department of Treasury, Financial Management Service or their web site www.fms.treas.gov/c570/c570html.
11. **Requests for Interpretation** - All questions or inquiries concerning the Bidding Documents or the Work shall be submitted in writing to the **Engineer**.
12. **Award** - Subject to any agreed extension of the period for holding Bids, the **Owner** will act within sixty (60) days after the date of Bid opening to award the Contract, reject any or all Bids or take any other appropriate action. The **Owner** expressly reserves the right to reject any or all Bids, waive any non-conformances, readvertise for Bids or withhold the award for any reason the **Owner** determines.

The award of this contract is subject to the 10-day review period provided by S763, N.J.S.A. 40:14B-14.
