January 31, 2008 – The Ocean County Utilities Authority announces the retirement of Kenneth Lee Eckard, Plant Operator of the Authority’s Central Water Pollution Control Facility located in Bayville, New Jersey. During his tenure as Plant Operator from May 30, 1990 through January 31, 2008, the Central Water Pollution Control Facility remained in full compliance with applicable New Jersey Pollutant Discharge Elimination System effluent limitations. This earned the facility “Gold” and “Platinum” level “Peak Performance Awards” for seventeen consecutive years from the National Association of Clean Water Agencies, previously known as the Association of Metropolitan Sewerage Agencies.
